POLICY (Dr. Stoker)

- □ Policy #323 Tobacco and Vaping Products Employees (2015)
 - This policy is mandated by law
 - Act 93 of 2019 and Act 111 of 2019 made modifications to the Pennsylvania Crimes Code regarding use and sale of tobacco and vaping products on school property. Both Acts contained similar language resulting in modifications to 18 Pa. C.S. Sections <u>6305</u> and <u>6306.1</u>. As a result, PSBA has updated the definitions and provisions in this policy to reflect those changes.

- More Comprehensive definition for "tobacco product" included which now includes vaping products.
- Committee supports the policy going to the full Board for first reading.
- □ Policy #810.1 Drug/Alcohol Testing Covered Drivers (2009)
 - This policy is required.
 - Act 131 of 2020 revised the Vehicle Code with provisions for <u>75 Pa. C.S.A.</u> <u>Sec. 1606</u> on requirements for commercial driver's license and <u>75 Pa.</u> <u>C.S.A. Sec. 1604</u> on notification requirements for drivers.
 - Committee supports the policy going to the full Board for first reading.
- Policy #810.3 <u>School Vehicle Drivers</u> (2019)
 - This policy is recommended for legal liability purposes.
 - <u>Act 131 of 2020</u> revised the Vehicle Code with provisions for <u>75 Pa. C.S.A.</u> <u>Sec. 1606</u> on requirements for commercial driver's license and <u>75 Pa.</u> <u>C.S.A. Sec. 1604</u> on notification requirements for drivers.
 - Committee supports the policy going to the full Board for first reading.
