Policy 006 - Meetings

- In the Voting section, language removed from "Actions that require the affirmative vote of two-thirds of those voting in the presence of a quorum" and moved to "Actions requiring the affirmative votes of two-thirds of the full membership of the Board." Since that section is now empty. It was removed.
- Under the "Actions requiring the affirmative votes of a majority of the full membership of the Board" section, "Combining or reorganizing into a larger school district" has been removed because this action only requires a simple majority. Language regarding charter school applications and joint schools or departments has been added.
- This policy is recommended to exhibit compliance with the Sunshine Act
- Committee supports moving policy to first reading during the September Board meeting.

- Policy 216.1 Supplemental Discipline Records
 - Revisions are based on <u>237 PA Code Rule 163. Release of Information to</u> <u>School</u>.
 - The juvenile probation office is required to provide notice to the building principal or his/her designee upon finding a juvenile, who is enrolled in the school entity, to be a delinquent. The Rule addresses requirements for the following:
 - The information to be contained in the notice to the school.
 - Acknowledgement of the notice of information.
 - Procedures for transfer of information upon the student's transfer to another school.
 - Maintenance of the information separately from the juvenile's official school record.
 - The limited purposes for which the district can use the information.
 - This policy is recommended for legal liability purposes
 - Committee supports moving policy to first reading during the September Board meeting.
- Policy 251 Students Experiencing Homelessness, Foster Care and Other Educational Instability
 - The only revision to this policy affects the Students With Disabilities section, which is located at the end of the policy.
 - Language was updated to reflect laws and practice and to avoid being problematic for districts as originally written and released by PSBA.
 - This is a mandated policy
 - Committee supports moving policy to first reading during the September Board meeting.
