D. Lehigh Carbon Community College 2023-2024 Budget

Total expenditures equal \$59,889,555 which represents an increase of \$1,223,766 or 2.1% over the 2022-2023 budget. Northern Lehigh's share of the total budget is \$171,379, a decrease of \$2,001 or -.1.2%. A copy of the budget was distributed at the January 9, 2023 Board meeting.

E. Carbon Lehigh Intermediate Unit 2023-2024 Budget

Approve a resolution regarding the 2023-2024 Carbon Lehigh Intermediate Unit Operational and Program Services budget. Total expenditures equal \$3,499,871 an increase of \$123,301 over the 2022-2023 budget. Northern Lehigh's share is proposed to be \$17,658, a decrease of \$357 from the 2022-2023 budget. F. Lehigh Career & Technical Institute 2023-2024 Budget

The general fund budget total is \$30,704,013.00 an increase of \$924,173. Northern Lehigh School District's portion of the 2023-2024 general fund budget is \$1,366,611.46, an increase of \$1,637.46. The expenditures for the Academic Center budget for the period of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023 total \$2,330,789.00 an increase of \$166,689.
