## A. CLIU 2024-2025 Facilities Plan Committee Report

Approve the following resolution to adopt the 2024-2025 Carbon Lehigh Intermediate Unit Facilities Plan Committee Report. (Attachment #9)

**RESOLVED:** It is recommended that the Northern Lehigh School District Board of Directors approve the 2024-2025 Facilities Plan Committee Report that was approved by the CLIU Facilities Plan Committee on March 12, 2024 and the CLIU 21 Board of Directors on March 18, 2024. In addition, the Board reaffirms its commitment to the original construct of the Facilities Planning, approved November 1, 1989, which consists of a series of prioritized inquiries to be considered in determining future locations of the CLIU and school district special education classes.

- B. Approve to authorize proper officials to enter into an agreement for one Northern Lehigh Lehigh School District student with special needs to attend Hogan Learning Academy LLC in accordance with the promises and covenants contained in the agreement. This agreement is effective August 19, 2024 and terminates on August 15, 2025. (<a href="Attachment#10">Attachment #10</a>)
- C. Approve administration to enter into an Affiliation Agreement with Cedar Crest College in order to provide our students with greater options to earn concurrent high school/college credit. The term of the Dual Credit Affiliation Agreement between Northern Lehigh School District and Cedar Crest College will be for April 9, 2024 to April 8, 2029. (Attachment #11)
- D. Approve administration to enter into an Affiliation agreement between Pennsylvania Western University and Northern Lehigh School District for a teacher preparation program. This program allows students at Pennsylvania Western University to student teach in our district in order for them to complete their practicum hours needed for graduation.
