New Modular Office At Slatington Elementary	Approve the purchase of a new modular office to replace the current modular office at Slatington Elementary from Williams Scotsman thru the Pennsylvania Education Joint Purchasing Council (PAEJPC) contract number AEPA IFB002-PA. Cost for this unit is \$124,377.00 plus \$8,000 for demolition and removal of the old unit plus a 1% AEPA Administrative Fee totaling \$133,700.77. The disconnect for the plumbing is included in the demolition. The electrical disconnect and reconnect is \$4715.00 plus a 1% administrative fee. The plumbing reconnect is \$2430.00 plus a \$23.30 administrative fee. Altronics Security System will cost \$399.00 for a total cost of the project, not including any permits through the borough, for a total cost of \$141,316.22. The 2004 AAA Bond will fund this project.
