Buildings & Grounds

- Softball/Baseball Complex & Solar Project updates
 - A coordination meeting was held on Dec 12th.
 - There are 5 wetlands identified in the proposed area of construction.
[Wetlands Map](#)
 - Engineers from ELA Sport are working with the Lehigh County Conservation Office to determine if there is a setback of 150 feet from any wetlands. This will help determine the availability of space for the solar array.
 - Since there are wetlands in the solar array area this will lengthen the permitting process for both projects if they remain combined on one permit.
 - ELA Sport is working with Lehigh County Conservation to determine if the projects need to remain as one permit or if they can be split into separate projects.
 - If they can be split into two separate projects. The board will have the option to move forward with the softball/baseball complex project as planned for in the late summer of 2023 as there is very minimal work to obtain a permit from the Conservation Office for this project.
 - If projects are split this will push back the solar array project timeline.
 - Bond proceeds for the softball/baseball project need to be spent within 3 years/ by Oct 2025. Since there is a timeline on spending these funds it may make sense, if the board chooses, to split the projects if possible and move forward with the softball/baseball project

- Bus Patrol
 - Our current vendor, SafeTransport, will discontinue their program on June 30th, 2023
 - Administration and Brandywine met virtually with Bus Patrol representatives on Dec 16th to hear about their program.
 - Bus Patrol directly offers Camera systems for transportation vehicles and partners with a preferred provider for GPS and Bus Routing Software.
