






ELA and Math

 - Develop coordinated, strategic approach to improving student engagement and attendance in the remote learning environment.







Students are identified as economically disadvantaged if they receive free or reduced lunch.

Students in need of remediation services are identified by test scores and other means and work with an academic interventionist in the area of need. This looks different in each school.

DISTRICT WIDE - ENGLISH LEARNERS

During 19-20 there were 13 ELs that took the WIDA/ACCESS for ELLS 2.0.
 Reading, Writing, Listening, Speaking

Pennsylvania administered and scored the 19-20 WIDA before the mandated school closures.

NLSD doesn't have data to report through the Future Ready PA Index for this area because the n-count required is 20.

FOCUS - ENGLISH LEARNERS

Addition of a second teacher to ELDP last year

Focus on newcomers and students with highest need.
